IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, to Aid in Rebuilding the Road in Township No.
Ten, Hancock County.

Resolved: That there be appropriated the sum of five
2 thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) to aid in repairing the road in
3 Hancock county, in Township No. Ten, known as the
4 "Blacks Woods Road," the money to be expended from
5 the fund for reconstruction and expended under the direc-
6 tion of the state highway commission, said amount to be
7 available for expenditure in the year nineteen hundred and
8 thirty.
