STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money to Aid in the Screening of
the Outlet of Lake Webb, in Franklin County.

Resolved: That the sum of twelve hundred and fifty
2 (\$1250.00) dollars be and hereby is appropriated, to be
3 taken from the appropriation for the maintenance of the
4 department of inland fisheries and game, to be expended
5 by the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, to aid in
6 screening Webb Lake, at the outlet, in Franklin county.
7 Provided, however, that said appropriation for the erection
8 of said screen shall not be available until some responsible
9 corporation or incorporated fish and game club, or the town

10 in which said outlet is located, or some other town in the
11 county of Franklin, in which said waters are situated, shall
12 have in legal town meeting, and having an article in the
13 warrant for said town meeting for that purpose, by vote
14 of record, voted to assume all liability for the keeping of
15 said screen at all times free from sticks, leaves and all debris
16 so that the same will not become clogged and prevent the
17 free running of water through the same. And provided,
18 further, that said appropriation shall not be available until
19 the citizens of the county in which said lake is situated
20 shall have paid into the state treasury the balance found
21 necessary by the commissioner of inland fisheries and game
22 to erect said screen. And provided, further, that if the
23 actual cost of said screen provided for in this resolve is less
24 than the amount appropriated therefor, the state shall be
25 liable for only one-half of the cost of such screen. Any
26 part of said appropriation not expended in the year nine-
27 teen hundred and twenty-nine shall be available during the
28 year nineteen hundred and thirty.
