STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of James H. Kerr of Rumford.

Resolved: That the State of Maine pay to James H. 2 Kerr of Rumford the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,-3 000) to compensate him for moneys, materials and labor 4 furnished to the State of Maine in the construction of the 5 substructure of the Hancock-Sullivan bridge in the State 6 of Maine during the years nineteen hundred and twenty-7 three, nineteen hundred and twenty-four, and nineteen hundred and twenty-five, and up to about the first day of Sep-9 tember, nineteen hundred and twenty-six. Said sum to

10 be paid in full settlement of claims and demands held by 11 James H. Kerr against State of Maine. Said sum to be 12 paid from bridge construction fund.
