IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Application for Soldiers' Bonus.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section three of chapter two hundred and sixty-four of the

- 2 public laws of nineteen hundred and nineteen, as amended
- 3 by chapter one hundred of the public laws of nineteen hun-
- 4 dred and twenty-one, and chapter fifty-five of the public
- 5 laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-three and chapter one
- 6 of the public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-five, is
- 7 hereby further amended by striking out the words "before
- 8 the first day of January, nineteen hundred twenty-nine," so
- 9 that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 3. Applications for such bonus shall be filed with 2 the adjutant general, on forms provided by him, before the 3 first day of July nineteen hundred thirty-three. Such appli-4 cation shall state facts sufficient to establish the status of 5 such applicant as soldier as defined herein, and shall be duly 6 verified.'
