**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE**

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money to Screen the Outlet of Syladobsis Lake, Commonly Called Lower Dobsis Lake, in Township Five, North Division, in the County of Washington.

Resolved: That the sum of five hundred dollars be and 2 hereby is appropriated to be taken from the appropriation 3 for the maintenance of the department of inland fisheries 4 and game, to be expended by the commissioner of inland 5 fisheries and game to aid in screening Syladobsis lake, pro- 6 vided, however, that no appropriation hereafter specified 7 for the erection of a screen at the outlet of said lake shall 8 be available until some responsible corporation, or incor-

9 porated fish and game club, or the town in which the outlet
10 of said lake to be screened is situated shall have in legal
11 town meeting and having an article in the warrant for said
12 town meeting for that purpose by vote of record voted to
13 assume all liability for the keeping of said screen at all
14 times free from sticks, leaves and all debris so that the
15 same will not become clogged and prevent the free running
16 of water through the same, and, provided further, that said
17 appropriation shall not be available until the citizens of the
18 county in which said lake to be screened is situated, shall
19 have paid into the state treasury the balance necessary as
20 found by the commissioner of inland fisheries and game to
21 erect said screen, and, provided further, if the actual cost
22 of said screen in this resolve be less than the amount ap-
23 propriated therefor, the state shall be liable for only one-
24 half of the cost of such screen. Any appropriation herein-
25 after named, or part thereof, not expended during the year
26 nineteen hundred and twenty-nine shall be available during
27 the years nineteen hundred and thirty.
