# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, to Provide a Committee to Investigate and Recommend Regarding Sales Tax.

Resolved: That a committee consisting of the chairman 2 of the board of state assessors, who shall be the chairman 3 hereof and four members of the present legislature, two 4 from the senate, to be appointed by the president of the 5 senate and two from the house to be appointed by the 6 speaker of the house, which committee shall during the 7 recess of the present legislature investigate the advisability 8 of an excise tax on certain or all sales of merchandise with 9 particular reference to the advisability of an excise tax

10 applicable to any retail mercantile business divided into 11 separate units conducted as branch mercantile establish12 ments. Said committee is authorized to investigate the laws 13 of the other states and is to report to the next legislature 14 its recommendations together with suggested legislation. The 15 governor and council are hereby authorized to pay out of 16 any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, all 17 such expense as may be incurred by said committee in their 18 investigation and report, but not to exceed two thousand 19 five hundred dollars.
