STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT to Appropriate Moneys for the Expenditures of the Government and for Other Purposes for the Years July First, Nineteen Hundred and Thirty-one to June Thirtieth, Nineteen Hundred and Thirty-two and from July First, Nineteen Hundred and Thirty-two to June Thirtieth, Nineteen Hundred and Thirty-three.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

In order to provide for the necessary expenditures of government for the next two fiscal years from July first, nineteen hundred and thirty-one to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred thirty-two and from July first, nineteen hundred thirty-two to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred thirty-three the following sums as designated in the following tabulations are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury, and except where otherwise specifically provided, the governor with the advice of the council is hereby authorized to draw his warrant on the state treasurer for the same.
