HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

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AN ACT Relating to Fees Paid by Dealers in Securities.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one hundred seventy-six of chapter fifty-seven of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out the entire section one hundred seventy-six and inserting in place thereof the following section:

'Sect. 176. Applicants for registration as dealer in securities, except in cases of renewal applications, shall pay to the bank commissioner, for the use of the state, filing fees of fifty dollars each. Dealers in securities shall pay to the bank commissioner, for the use of the state, fees as follows, to wit: for registration or renewal of registration of dealers in securities, fifty dollars; for registration or renewal of registration of salesman or agent of dealers in securities, ten dollars each; for certified copy of dealers certificates, fifty cents each.'
