AN ACT Relating to Registration Fees Payable for Motor  
Vehicles.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Registration fees. Section fifty-four of chapter twenty-nine of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out in the third line of the last paragraph of said section the words "October and the thirty-first day of December, one-half the registration fee shall be charged" and substituting in place thereof the following words: 'April and the thirtieth day of September, three-fourths of the annual registration fee shall be charged and during the period between the first day of October and the thirty-first day of December, one-fourth of the annual registration fee shall be charged,' so that the last paragraph of said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Fees for registration of motor vehicles. On any application for registration applied for by an owner resident of this state, of a motor vehicle or trailer, not including a log hauler, or traction engine, during the period between the first day of April and the thirtieth day of September, three-fourths of the annual registration fee shall be charged and during the period between the first day of October and the thirty-first day of December, one-fourth of the annual registration fee shall be charged. The secretary of state upon granting the application

shall register in a book or upon suitable index cards to be kept for the purpose, the vehicle described in the application, giving to its owner a distinguishing number or other mark, and shall thereupon issue a certificate of registration which shall contain the name, place of residence and address of the owner.'
