STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Pools at State Fish Hatcheries and
Feeding Stations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, sec. 21, relating to pools at state fish hatcheries and feeding stations. Section twenty-one of chapter thirty-eight of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting in the first line of said section, as a new first sentence, the following:

‘Sect. 21. Closed seasons in the several waters of the state. All pools connected with state fish hatcheries and feeding stations shall be closed to all fishing at all times.’
