IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Licenses Issued by the Department of
Inland Fisheries and Game.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S. c. 38; relating to licenses issued by the department of inland fisheries and game. Chapter thirty-eight of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section, to be numbered section one hundred nine:

'Sect. 109. Expiration date of licenses. All licenses and permits issued under the provisions of this chapter, with the exception of the thirty-day non-resident fishing license, shall expire on December thirty-first following the date of issue.'
