## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Closing Oosoola Stream, in Norridgewock, to Hunting and Trapping.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Oosoola Stream, commonly called Mill Stream, situated in the town of Norridgewock, is hereby closed to all hunting or trapping up to the high water mark, from Jewett's Line, so-called, down to Percival's saw mill, which mill is located near the mouth of said Oosoola Stream.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall be subject to the general penalty provided in section one hundred seven of chapter thirty-eight of the revised statutes for violation of the fish and game laws.
