## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Regulating Fishing in Fourth Buttermilk, Third Buttermilk, Duck, and Little Benson Ponds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Fishing regulated in Fourth Buttermilk, Third Buttermilk, Duck, and Little Benson Ponds. The following ponds shall be closed to all fishing except fly fishing: Fourth Buttermilk, Third Buttermilk, or Burton, so called, Duck Pond and Little Benson, all in the town of Bowerbank.
