STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relative to Dogs in the Woods or Forests.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, sec. 64, relating to dogs in the woods or forests. Section sixty-four of chapter thirty-eight of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following: 'Owners of dogs shall not allow or permit them to run at large in the woods or forests unless accompanied by their owner or keeper. Whoever violates this provision shall be liable to the penalty provided in section one hundred seven of this chapter.'
