STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Registration of Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Registration fees for periods less than one year. Section fifty-four of chapter twenty-nine of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out in the third and fourth lines of the last paragraph of said section the words "during the period between the first day of October and the thirty-first day of December, one-half the registration fee shall be charged" and substituting in place thereof the words 'the registration fee shall be reduced by one-twelfth for each month which shall have elapsed since the beginning of the registration year,' so that the last paragraph of said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Registration fees for periods less than one year. On any application for registration applied for by an owner resident of this state, of a motor vehicle or trailer, not including a log hauler, or traction engine, the registration fee shall be reduced by one-twelfth for each month which shall have elapsed since the beginning of the registration year. The secretary of state upon granting the application shall register in a book or upon suitable index cards to be kept for the purpose, the vehicle described in the application, giving to its owner a distinguishing number or other mark, and shall thereupon issue a certifi-

cate of registration which shall contain the name, place of residence and address of the owner.'

Sect. 2. The provisions of this act shall go into effect January one, nineteen hundred thirty-two.
