STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Chauffeurs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section thirty-six of chapter twenty-nine of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out in the third paragraph thereof, the words, "five dollars; provided, however that if such applicant already holds on operator's license the accompanying fee shall be three dollars," and inserting in place thereof the words 'two dollars.' so that said third paragraph as amended shall read as follows:

'Every application for a chauffeur's license shall be accompanied by a fee of two dollars.'
