AN ACT to Regulate Fishing in Clearwater Pond.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, sect. 21, relating to fishing in Clearwater Pond, in Industry and Farmington. Section twenty-one of chapter thirty-eight of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out, in the ninety-seventh line thereof, the words "June first of each year" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words 'the season opening in the spring', so that the reference to Clearwater Pond, in lines ninety-three to ninety-eight inclusive of said section twenty-one shall read as follows: 'Clearwater pond (1929, c. 342), situated in the towns of Industry and Farmington in Franklin county, except by trolling or by fly-fishing in the ordinary manner, provided, however, that plug fishing, so-called, from permanent wharf or shore with line not exceeding twenty feet in length shall be legal from the season opening in the spring until September thirtieth following of each year, both days inclusive;'
