AN ACT Relating to Penalties for Violations of Rules and Regulations of the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S. c. 38, sec. 107, relating to penalties for violations of rules and regulations of the department of inland fisheries and game. Section one hundred seven of chapter thirty-eight of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the word "thereunder," in the second line thereof, the following: 'or rules and regulations heretofore promulgated and still in full force and effect,' so that the first paragraph of said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 107. Penalties. Whoever violates any of the foregoing provisions and rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, or rules and regulations heretofore promulgated and still in full force and effect, excepting only those for the violation of which specific penalties have been hereinbefore provided, may be punished by a fine of not more than three hundred dollars and costs, or by imprisonment for not more than ninety days, or by both said fine and imprisonment, except as hereafter noted.'
