STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT to Authorize Beal College to Confer Certain Degrees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Beal College, a corporation organized under the general Laws of the State of Maine, is hereby authorized until July 15, 1933, to confer the degree of bachelor of commercial science (B. C. S.) after three full years of study; and the degree of bachelor of secretarial science (B. S. S.) after three full years of study.
