STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relative to the Organization of Corporations Without Capital Stock.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section two of chapter seventy of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

'If all the signers of the application to the justice of the peace shall in writing waive notice and fix a time and place of such meeting, no notice or publication shall be necessary. All prior organizations under this chapter at which all the signers of the application to the justice of the peace waived notice and fixed a time and place for meeting are hereby legalized.'

so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 2. Such applicant may call it, by reading the warrant in the presence and hearing of each, or by leaving an attested copy thereof at his last and usual place of abode, at least fourteen days before the day of meeting, or by publishing an attested copy thereof in some newspaper printed in said county, for two weeks successively, the first publication to be at least fourteen days before the day of meeting. If all the signers of the application to the justice of the peace shall in writing waive notice and fix a time and place of such meeting, no notice or publication shall be necessary. All prior organiz-

ations under this chapter at which all the signers of the application to the justice of the peace waived notice and fixed a time and place for meeting are hereby legalized.
