IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Prohibiting Ice Fishing in Taylor Pond in Auburn in Androscoggin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Ice fishing prohibited in Taylor Pond. Section twenty-one of chapter thirty-eight of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting in the twentieth line of said section, on page six hundred fifty-nine of the revised statutes, after the word "trout" the following words: '; Taylor Pond, in the city of Auburn in Androscoggin county.' so that said section as amended shall prohibit ice fishing in the said Taylor Pond.
