STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the Apportionment of Construction of Bridges under the Bridge Act.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The second paragraph of section sixty-three of chapter twenty-eight of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out the word "four" in the third line thereof, and inserting in place thereof the word 'ten,' so that said second paragraph as amended shall read as follows:

'Providing, however, that whenever there is built or rebuilt under sections sixty-two to seventy-four any bridge upon a state highway, which bridge lies in whole or in part in a town of ten thousand inhabitants or less, according to the last federal census, the county or counties wherein such bridge is located shall pay the amount or amounts required by the provisions of sections sixty-two to seventy-three, and the state shall pay the balance.'
