STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT to Prevent the Poluting of the Waters of the West
Basin of China Lake.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

No person shall bathe in the waters of the west basin of
China Lake, situated in the towns of China and Vassalboro in
Kennebec County. Any person violating the provisions of
this act shall be liable to a fine payable to the state of not more
than twenty dollars for each offense.
