STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Prohibiting the Shooting of Wild Birds and Water-
fowl on Simpson's Pond, in Roque Bluffs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Shooting of wild birds and waterfowl prohibited on Simpson's Pond. It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt, pursue, shoot at or kill, any wild bird or waterfowl on Simpson's Pond, or from the shores of said pond, which pond is situated in the town of Roque Bluffs, in the county of Washington.

Sect. 2. Possession of birds taken prohibited. It shall also be unlawful for any person to have in possession at any time any wild bird or waterfowl taken in violation of the provisions of this act.

Sect. 3. Penalty for violations. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall be subject to the general penalty provided in section one hundred seven of chapter thirty-eight of the revised statutes for violation of the fish and game laws.
