STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Fishing in the Big Magalloway River.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The commissioner of inland fishing and game is authorized and directed to place two red posts on opposite banks of the Big Magalloway river at the point where said river enters into Azischohos lake, said posts to be set at the high water mark of Azischohos lake.
