STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Fishing in Spear Stream, in Peru.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. Fishing in Spear stream and tributaries, in Peru, regulated. It shall be unlawful for any person to fish for, take, catch or kill any kind of fish in Spear stream, or in any tributaries to said Spear stream, in Peru, in the county of Oxford, except on Tuesday and Thursday of each week during the open season provided by the general law.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall be subject to the general penalty provided in section one hundred seven of chapter thirty-eight of the revised statutes for violation of the fish and game laws.
