STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT to Regulate Fishing in Hill's Pond in Perkins Plantation in the County of Franklin.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. It shall be unlawful for any person to fish for, take, catch, or kill any kind of fish at any time in Hill's Pond, so-called, which pond is situated in Perkins Plantation in the County of Franklin, except in the ordinary manner of casting with unbaited, artificial flies, or fly fishing, so-called.

Sect. 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to take, catch, or kill more than six fish in all in said Hill's Pond in any one day. It shall also be unlawful for any person to have in possession in any one day more than six fish in all taken in said pond.

Sect. 3. It shall be unlawful for any person, to take, catch or kill, at any time, any trout less than eight inches in length or any land-locked salmon less than fourteen inches in length taken from said Hill's Pond. It shall also be unlawful for any person to have in possession at any time, any trout less than eight inches in length or any land-locked salmon less than fourteen inches in length, taken from said Hill's Pond.

Sect. 4. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall pay a fine of not less than ten dollars, nor more than thirty dollars, and costs of prosecution, for each offense; and in addition thereto one dollar for each fish taken, caught, killed or had in possession in violation of any provision of this act.
