STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Regulating Fishing in Leeman Brook, or Ladd
Brook, so-called, in Abbot.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Leeman Brook, or Ladd Brook, so-called, open to fishing. Leeman Brook, or Ladd Brook, so-called, in the town of Abbot, county of Piscataquis, is hereby opened to fishing under the provisions of the general law.

Sect. 2. Inconsistent laws repealed. All acts and parts of acts, or rules and regulations of the department of inland fisheries and game, inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
