IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Fishing in Hedgehog, Brown, and Trout
Ponds, in Piscataquis County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, sec. 22, relating to fishing in Hedgehog, Brown, and Trout Ponds. Section twenty-two of chapter thirty-eight of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end of the thirty-fourth paragraph thereof the following: 'and provided that it shall be unlawful to take or have in possession in any one day more than ten trout from Hedgehog, Brown, and Trout ponds, in township eight, range ten, in the county of Piscataquis.'
