IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT to Enable Special Officers of Bangor Police to Receive Benefits of Departments.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

William F. Banks and Levi E. Lambert who have served as special officers of the Bangor Police Force for seventeen and thirteen years respectively are and shall be entitled to all and the same rights, privileges, pensions and benefits under the laws and ordinances relating to the Bangor Police Department as any regular member.
