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STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

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AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Judge of Lincoln  
Municipal Court.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The third paragraph of section nineteen of chapter two hundred thirty-nine of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred thirteen, as amended by chapter eighty-nine of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred twenty-seven, is hereby amended by striking out the words "seven hundred" in the first and second lines thereof and inserting in place thereof the words 'two thousand', so that said paragraph as amended shall read as follows:

'The judge of said court shall receive the salary of two thousand dollars per year, to be paid him in equal quarterly payments from the county treasury of Lincoln county, which shall be in full for his services as such judge, except as hereinbefore provided.'
