STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Qualification of Trust Company Directors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section seventy-four of chapter fifty-seven of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out the entire section seventy-four and by inserting in place thereof the following section:

'Sect. 74. No person shall be eligible to the position of a director of any such company who is not the actual owner of stock amounting to one thousand dollars par value, free from encumbrance.'
