IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Ice Fishing in Certain Waters.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Certain ponds opened to ice fishing. The following waters, in Oxford county, are hereby opened to ice fishing: South Pond and Lincoln Pond in Buckfield, and Swan Pond in Hartford.
