STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT to set off that part of Dunn's Point located in the
Town of Rome to the Town of Belgrade.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. That such part of the town of Rome, in Kennebec county, as is located on the northerly end of Dunn's Point, so called, together with the inhabitants thereof, is hereby set off from said town of Rome and annexed to and made a part of the town of Belgrade in said county of Kennebec.

Sect. 2. Such sum as represents the valuation of said point as shown by the assessors' books of the town of Rome for the year 1930 is hereby deducted from the valuation of the town of Rome, from which state and county taxes are assessed, and added to the valuation of said town of Belgrade.

Sect. 3. The said town of Belgrade shall be holden to pay to the town of Rome such proportion of the debts now owing by said town of Rome, after deducting therefrom all debts due said town, as the last annual valuation of the inhabitants of that part of said point now in Rome shall bear to the last annual valuation of all of the inhabitants of said town of Rome.
