AN ACT to extend the open season on partridge.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, sec. 55, increasing open season on partridge. Section fifty-five of chapter thirty-eight of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding after the word "partridge" in the first line of the second paragraph thereof the words 'from December first to September thirtieth of the following year, both days inclusive' and by inserting after the word "and" in the same line the word 'on', so that the portion of said second paragraph of section fifty-five relating to closed season on partridge and woodcock, in lines one to three inclusive, as amended, shall read as follows: 'On partridge from December first to September thirtieth of the following year, both days inclusive, and on woodcock from November first to September thirtieth of the following year, both days inclusive;'
