IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Land Damages.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

The state shall pay all damages arising from change of location and or change of grade in the built up portion of the town of Wiscasset resulting from the construction of the state highway running through said town, and the construction of a bridge to replace the present bridge connecting Wiscasset and Davis Island, and from the construction of an overhead crossing over the tracks of the Maine Central Railroad.
