## STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the Property of an Unincorporated or Voluntary Association, Organization, Society, Lodge or Club, and Authorizing the Trustees Thereof to Transfer the Title to the Same.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Any real estate or personal property or both, which has been heretofore or may hereafter be conveyed to any unincorporated or voluntary association, organization, society, lodge or club, shall be deemed to have been conveyed to the trustee or trustees thereof for the use and benefit of such association, organization, society, lodge or club, and such trustee or trustees or their successors in trust, upon the authority duly conferred in accordance with its constitution and by-laws by such association, organization, society, lodge or club, may pledge, mortgage, sell, transfer and convey any such real or personal property or both, for and in behalf of such association, organization, society, lodge or club, and transfer the title thereof, with the same effect as they could have done if such real or personal property or both had been conveyed to such trustee or trustees for and in behalf of and to the use of such association, organization, society, lodge or club, instead of to the association, organization, society, lodge or club itself.
