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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

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AN ACT Relating to the Charter of Old Town.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter seventy-one of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred ninety-one is hereby amended by adding thereto the following sections, to be numbered as follows:

'Sect. 46. The mayor and board of aldermen may provide by ordinance for a system of civil service rules for the appointment, promotion, lay-off, reinstatement, suspension and removal of the members of the police department and of the fire department, and for a civil service commission to administer the same.

Sect. 47. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.'
