STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT to Permit the City of Auburn to Pension Present
and Former Members of its Fire Department.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The city of Auburn may pension such superannuated members of its fire department and such former members of its said fire department as have served twenty-five years therein and have reached the age of sixty-five years as the city council may determine, and such pension shall not exceed five hundred dollars (\$500) per year per pensioner and shall be payable at such times as said city council may vote.
