STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Regulating Fishing in Milliken's Mill Pond, in the
town of Old Orchard Beach, in the County of York.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person to fish for, take, catch or kill, with unbaited, artificial flies, or fly fishing so-called, any kind of fish at any time in the waters of Milliken's Mill Pond, situated in the town of Old Orchard Beach, in the county of York.

It shall also be unlawful for any person to take, catch or kill more than five fish in all in any one day in the waters of said Milliken's Mill Pond, in said town of Old Orchard Beach, in said county of York.
