HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT to Open Craig Pond in the Town of Orland to Ice
Fishing.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Craig Pond, in the town of Orland, is hereby opened to ice
fishing for salmon and trout during the open season.
