STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relative to the Issuing of Hunting and Guiding
Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Any person who, while in pursuit of wild game, shoots and kills a human being, through mistaking a human being for wild game, shall thereafter not be eligible to procure a hunting or guiding license nor shall any town clerk or other person authorized by law to issue such license, issue such license to such persons.
