STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Regulating Fishing in Tributaries to Heald Pond in Moose River Plantation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Heald Pond tributaries closed to all fishing. It shall be unlawful for any person to fish for, take, catch or kill, any kind of fish at any time, in any tributaries to Heald pond, which pond is situated in Moose River plantation in the county of Somerset.

Sect. 2. Penalty for violation. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall be subject to the general penalty provided in section one hundred seven of chapter thirty-eight of the revised statutes for violation of the fish and game laws.
