STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Service Charges by Water or Gas Companies in Portland, South Portland or Westbrook.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

No service charges. No water or gas company, doing business in the city of Portland, South Portland or Westbrook shall make, to the inhabitants of said city, any service charge for the reading of meters. The public utilities commission shall enforce this section, proceeding under the provisions of chapter sixty-two of the revised statutes as far as they are applicable.
