STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Non-resident's Registration of Motor
Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section ninety-two of chapter twelve of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out in the second line of said section the words "owned or controlled by a resident of this state"; and by adding at the end of said section the following words: 'or gives satisfactory proof of legal residence outside of the state,' so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 92. Payment of tax must precede registration. No motor vehicle shall be registered under the provisions of chapter twenty-nine until the owner or person controlling the same has paid the excise tax herein provided to the city or town wherein he resides, or gives satisfactory proof of legal residence outside of the state.'
