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AN ACT Providing for Semi-annual Inspection of Motor  
Vehicles.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Motor vehicles to be inspected semi-annually. Chapter twenty-nine of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting after section one hundred three of said chapter a new section to be numbered one hundred three A, and to read as follows:

'Sect. 103A. Semi-annual inspection of motor vehicles. Once in the month of April and once in the month of September, each motor vehicle in the state shall be inspected for mechanical and other defects. The secretary of state shall designate the manner in which this inspection shall be carried out, and the ground that it shall cover. Each motorist shall pay therefor an inspection fee of two dollars to the inspector.
