STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Trial Lists in Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 91, sec. 21, relating to trial courts, amended. Section twenty-one of chapter ninety-one of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding to the third paragraph thereof, the following words: 'at each term of which the court shall place upon the trial list and hear only such civil actions pending in said court as may be more conveniently tried at that term, except that by agreement of attorneys interested other cases may be placed upon such trial list.', so that the third paragraph of said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Aroostook: At Houlton on the first Tuesdays of April and November for civil and criminal business, and at Caribou on the first Tuesday of February and second Tuesday of September for civil business only; at each term of which the court shall place upon the trial list and hear only such civil actions pending in said court as may be more conveniently tried at that term, except that by agreement of attorneys interested other cases may be placed upon such trial list.'
