IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Fees for Registration of Trailers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 29, sec. 54, paragraph C; relating to fees for registration of trailers. Paragraph C, section fifty-four of chapter twenty-nine of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding to said paragraph the following: 'Trailers having a carrying capacity of four thousand pounds or more shall be classified and rated as trucks,' so that said paragraph, as amended, shall read as follows:

'C. Trailers.

Per 100 lbs.
gross weight
• of vehicle
Equipped with and load
Pneumatic tires15 cents
Solid tires40 cents
Iron, steel or other hard tires75 cents
Trailers having a carrying capacity of four thousand pounds
or more shall be classified and rated as trucks.'
