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AN ACT Relating to Temporary Allowances in Libels for  
Divorce

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section six of chapter seventy-three of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the word "vacation" in the first line of said section the words 'or the judge of the Probate Court for the county where said libel is returnable,' so that said section when amended will read as follows:

'Sect. 6. Pending libel, wife's expenses to be paid by husband. Pending a libel, the court, or any justice thereof in vacation, or the judge of the Probate Court for the county where said libel is returnable, may order the husband to pay to the clerk, for the wife, sufficient money for her defense or prosecution thereof, and to make reasonable provision for her separate support; enter such decree for the care and custody of the minor children as the court deems proper; and enforce obedience by appropriate processes.'
