STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the Division of Inheritance Taxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter seventy-seven of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

'Sect. 35. Division of taxes when collected. Upon receipt by the treasurer of the state of any of the taxes provided for in this chapter the treasurer shall forthwith pay to the treasurer of the town where said decedent was domiciled within the state of Maine, a sum equal to eight per cent of the tax so collected and to the county in which said decedent was domiciled a sum equal to two per cent of the tax so collected.'
